Surplus Property Bid Notice

The Hillsboro Fire Protection District is accepting sealed bids for the following surplus vehicle:

2013 Ford Explorer/Police Interceptor Model

Mileage: Approximately 89,428

Motor: 6-cylinder, 3.7 liter

Fuel: Gas

Transmission: Automatic

This vehicle served as the Assistant Chief and Fire Chief's vehicle. It has been serving in that capacity since 2012. The apparatus is being replaced as part of the Fire District capital replacement plan.

Bid Submitted by Other Emergency Services Agencies

Should another emergency services agency (police department, fire district/department, EMS/Ambulance agency wish to bid on this vehicle and be awarded the bid, all fire department related equipment will be left with the vehicle including but not limited to light bar and controller, command/storage box, SCBA holder, Fire Extinguisher etc.

Bid Submitted by the General Public

If the submitted is by the general public, all fire department related equipment will be removed from the vehicle prior to the winning bidder picking up the vehicle.

Anyone interested in submitting a bid for this vehicle must do so by March 9th, 2022, at the close of the business day which is 4:00 P.M. central standard time. Bids submitted after the listed time will not be considered. Bids will be opened at the regular Board of Directors Meeting on March 9th, 2022, at 7:00 P.M. The person, business or other agency with the highest bid will be awarded the vehicle, however the Board of Directors retains the right to accept or reject any and all bids. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the bidder's name and contact information. If the successful bidder is not present at the Board of Directors Meeting during the time of bid opening, they will be contacted the following day, March 10th, 2022. The vehicle will be available for pick up immediately for other emergency services agencies or by March 17th, 2022, for the public to allow time for removal of the light bar and other equipment. The vehicle must be paid for and picked up from the Hillsboro Fire Protection District no later than March 31st, 2022, at 4:00 P.M. central standard time. In the event the winning bidder cannot pay or pick up the vehicle by March 31st, 2022, the next highest bidder will be awarded the bid.

The winning bidder must pay for the vehicle with a money order or certified check.

This vehicle is sold as is. The district assumes no liability nor warranties this vehicle in any way.

The Hillsboro Fire Protection District reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
